

## WHAT IS A UNIT CAPTAIN?

Unit Captains are a vital link between homeowners and the HOA. Unit Captains provide information for homeowners and provide a “voice” for homeowners when there are questions and concerns. Unit Captains attend a meeting on the first Tuesday of every month from 3:45-5:00 p.m. to become aware of current HOA issues.

If you have not heard from your Unit Captain, it may mean your Unit does not have a volunteer. There are currently 73 Unit Captains. However, there are some units without captains: **Units 27B, 45A, 45B, and 46A** do not have Unit Captains and have been without them for quite some time. **Units 28, 35, 36, 36A, and 44** need additional Unit Captains because the units are big.

If you have a Unit Captain and haven't heard from him/her, please make his/her job easier by making contact and giving your Unit Captain your e-mail address. Unit Captains must personally ask homeowners for e-mail addresses which is difficult when there may be 200 homes in one unit. All of the Unit Captains are listed at this address:
